## **NOTICE OF RACE**

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

### **1. RULES**

- 1.1. The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. ILCA class rule 7(a) is restricted so that only one person can be on board while racing.
- 1.3. [DP] RRS 40.1 applies at all times while afloat.
- 1.4. RRS Appendix P, special procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.5. RRS Appendix T, Arbitration, will apply.
- 1.6. German national prescriptions will apply.
- 1.7. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence. For the national prescriptions of the German Sailing Federation (DSV) the German text will take precedence.

### **2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 2.1. The Sailing Instructions will only be published online at

section Notice Board from September, 29th on. There will be no paper version available at the venue. This changes RRS 90.2(a).



### 3. *COMMUNICATION*

- 3.1. The official notice board is located on the event website.
- 3.2. [NP] [DP] While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

### 4. *[NP] [DP] ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY*

- 4.1. The event is open to all boats of the class(es) as follows:  
ILCA 6 w (women), ILCA 6 m (men) und ILCA 7
- 4.2. Competitors shall either have a valid sailing license of the DSV, "Youth sailor license", "Sport sailor license" or a valid official license prescribed or recommended for the sailing area. Members of other national federations shall have an adequate sailing license of their national authority.
- 4.3. Each competitor shall be a member of a club affiliated to his national authority of World Sailing.
- 4.4. Each competitor who is a member of a club affiliated to DSV shall have registered on the website of DSV.
- 4.5. Eligible boats shall register online at the IDM ILCA Class 2023 manage2sail website <https://manage2sail.com/de-DE/event/IDMILCA23#!/> no later than 15<sup>th</sup> September 2023, pay the required fees and complete the registration on site.
- 4.6. Competitors under 18 years of age shall present at registration a completed and signed parent (guardian) consent and declaration form (NoR 18.5). The form is available for download at the event website.
- 4.7. No entries of sailors and/or support persons from Russia and Belarus will be accepted until further notice. Existing entries will be rejected.

### 5. *FEE*

- 5.1. Entry fees are as follows:

- 5.2. The entry fee shall be paid to the bank account of RSVM at Müritz-Sparkasse, BIC: NOLADE21WRN, IBAN: DE02150501000641004079 naming the event and the sail number.
- 5.3. The required fee shall be paid online upon entering, even if the entry is cancelled later or the boat or support person vessel does not show up. The fee is non-refundable, except for the event or class being cancelled by the organizing authority or if the entry is rejected under RRS 76.



## 6. *[DP] ADVERTISING*

- 6.1. Boats may be required to display advertising and bow numbers chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 6.2. It is prohibited to distribute and display advertising material both in the area of the shore facilities and jetties or to fix such material separately on the boats and harbour facilities, unless prior permission has been given by the organizing authority.

- 7.3. On the first scheduled racing day a skippers meeting will be held at 0930 hrs. Details will be posted in the Sailing Instructions.

- 7.4. The schedule of races and dates of racing is as follows:

- 7.5. On the last scheduled day of racing, no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.

## 8. *[NP] [DP] EQUIPMENT INSPECTION*

- 8.1. Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate and be able to produce it if requested.
- 8.2. Boats shall also comply with RRS 78.1 between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the event.
- 8.3. Boats may be inspected at any time. Boats shall be presented fully rigged with all control lines in position.
- 8.4. Buoyancy, wet clothing, measurement and equipment checks may be made throughout the regatta at the discretion of the class Representative, Race Committee, Technical Committee or the International Jury.
- 8.5. No first measurements will be made.
- 8.6. Equipment inspection timeslots shall be booked in advance online at <https://www.slottr.com/sheets/18277654>



## 9. VENUE

- 9.1. The regatta will be hosted at Röbel/Müritz, Germany.
- 9.2. Addendum B and C show the location of the regatta harbour.
- 9.3. The Race Office is located at the regatta harbour, shown in Addendum B.
- 9.4. The race area will be on Lake MÜRITZ, shown in Addendum C.

## 10. COURSES

- 10.1. The courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

## 11. INTERNATIONAL JURY

- 11.1. The intention is to appoint an international jury in accordance with RRS 91(b).  
The right of appeal from an international jury decision is denied as provided in RRS 70.5.

## 12. SCORING

- 12.1. The Low-Point Scoring System (RRS Appendix A) will be applied.
- 12.2. Four (4) races are required to be completed to constitute a championship.
- 12.3.
  - a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
  - b) When five (5) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. This changes RRS A2.
  - c) A maximum of eleven (11) races will be scored.
- 12.4. If there are more than 80 participants in a division, the participants might be divided into further fleets. The composition of the fleets will be made as described in the Sailing Instructions.

## 13. [NP] [DP] SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

- 13.1. All support person vessels shall be registered with the organizing authority. When support persons are present in the racing area, they are required to comply with local legislation and - if applicable - the 'Event Support Team Regulations', that will be posted on the event website. The organizing authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.
- 13.2. Support persons and coaches shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment.
- 13.3. All support vessels shall be equipped with a functioning engine safety cut-out switch (kill switch) which shall remain attached to the support person at the helm at all times while the engine is running. Failure to comply may be misconduct and/or result in expulsion from the event.
- 13.4. Support person vessels shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3,000,000 € (or the equivalent) per incident.

## 14. [DP] BERTHING

- 14.1. Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in the harbour.



## 15. *PRIZES*

- 15.1. Medals will be awarded to the first three places and certificates to the first six places by the organizer.
- 15.2. The following title will be awarded to the winners in each class:

## 16. *SUPPORT BOATS AND SUPPORT PERSONNEL*

- 16.1 Coaches and support persons must register at the race office showing the following documents:
  - Engine registration document of the rib (engine brand name - engine serial number);
  - Current insurance of the engine;
- 16.2 Support boats with team leaders, coaches and other support personnel shall stay outside areas where boats are racing from the time of the starting sequence until all boats have finished or the race committee signals a postponement, general recall or abandonment. Support boats shall comply with any reasonable request from a regatta official.

## 17. *MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT*

- 17.1. By participating of the Championship, competitors automatically grant to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.
- 17.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified and supplied by the organizing authority.
- 17.3. Competitors may be required to be available for interviews at the regatta.

## 18. *DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY*

- 18.1 The responsibility for the decision of the person in charge to participate in a race or to continue with it is solely with him, to that extent he also takes the responsibility for his crew. The helmsman is responsible for the qualification and the correct nautical conduct of his crew as well as for the suitability and the transport-safe condition of the registered boat. In cases of Force Majeure or on grounds of administrative orders or for safety reasons the organizer is entitled to make changes in the realization of the event or to cancel the event. In these cases there does not exist any liability for compensation of the organizer to the participant. In case of a violation of obligations that do not constitute primary respectively material contractual duties (cardinal obligations), the liability of the organizer, no matter because of which cause in law, for material and property damages of all kinds and their consequences that arise to the participant during or in connection with the participation in the event resulting from a conduct of the organizer, his representatives, servants or agents, is restricted to damages that were caused willfully or grossly negligent. When a violation of cardinal obligations occurs, in cases of simple negligence the liability of the organizer is limited to foreseeable, typically occurring damages. To the extent that the liability for damages of the organizer is excluded or restricted, the participant also relieves the staff – employees and representatives, agents, servants, sponsors and individuals who



provide or drive salvage, safety or rescue vessels or assist with their use - from the individual liability for damages, as well as also all other individuals who were instructed to act in connection with the realization of the event.

- 18.2. The effective racing rules of World Sailing, the class rules as well as the regulations of the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions are to be complied with and are expressly recognized.
- 18.3. The law of the Federal Republic of Germany shall apply.
- 18.4. All participants and crew shall sign the form of disclaimer of liability and copyright at registration.
- 18.5. Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a form of disclaimer of liability and copyright signed by parent (guardian) at registration. This signature implies also the consent to the participation. The forms can be downloaded from the registration website.

## 19. *[DP] INSURANCE*

- 19.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid and for the racing area suitable third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 1,500,000 € per incident or the equivalent. The proof of insurance has to be presented at the registration.

## 20. *DATA PROTECTION NOTES*

- 20.1. The data of the regatta participants (name, club, placement) can be published by the organizing club on notices as well as on its website. The hosting club also reserves the right to pass on the above data to the press, print or telemedia. This applies equally to photos and other digital data of the participants that were taken in connection with the event. We refer you to the privacy statement in Appendix 1.

## 21. *FURTHER INFORMATION*

### B. ACCOMMODATION & FOOD

- 21.1. Pitches for tents, cars (for accommodation) and campers are available at the regatta harbor.
- 21.2. For using this places from 29.09.-04.10.2023 a charge of 20,00€ per camper per day and 15,00€ per car per day and 10,00€ per tent per day has to be payed . Before and after this period the taxes of the Marina Röbel/Müritz are valid.
- 21.3. You will be able to book breakfast and “make-your-own-packed-lunch-from-buffet” at 8,50€ per day. Please book it within 15th september. All meals are served in the boat hall. A booking of accommodations outside the harbor can be done through tourist information of the city Röbel/Müritz, Guest House.

## **Appendix 1**

### **PRIVACY DECLARATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN A REGATTA**

#### **§ 1 GENERAL**

The staging of a regatta by the Röbbeler Sailing Club "Müritz" e.V., Müritzpromenade 20 in 17207 Röbel/Müritz

(hereinafter "we" or "RSV ") necessitates the collection of data from all participants.

Irrespective of whether you have registered by internet, by e-mail or in hard copy form, the protection of your personal information is of paramount importance to us. Therefore, we would like to inform you exactly which personal data provided by you is collected, further processed or otherwise used (collectively referred to as "processing") by us for the purposes of documenting our regatta.

#### **§ 2 RESPONSIBLE BODY**

The RSV is responsible for the processing of personal data in the context of regatta participation. Further information about us, e.g. an e-mail address, can be found under para. 7 b of this declaration as well as the imprint on our website ([www.rsvm.de](http://www.rsvm.de)).

#### **§ 3 PURPOSE AND LEGAL BASIS OF DATA PROCESSING**

Insofar as personal data of participants is processed within the framework of the regatta participation,

this is done for the performance and documentation of the regatta as well as for the fulfillment of our obligations towards class associations, the German Sailing Association or the respective national sailing associations. In addition, we may use your personal information in the context of fraud prevention and as evidence.

Personal Data used for generating statistics (e.g. about the development of the number of participants) is strictly anonymized. The anonymized data and statistics are used solely for the respectively stated purposes.

Where not specifically otherwise justified in the body of this statement, the legal basis for the processing of your personal data in the context of regatta participation is Article 6 para. 1 (b) of the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"). Should we use the data to prevent or to prove misuse, this is done on the basis of legitimate interest (Art. 6 para. 1 (f) GDPR).

Please note that we will possibly be unable to process your registration if you do not provide us with the relevant personal data, the consequence of which will be that you will not be able to participate in the regatta.

Insofar as you have given us consent for the processing of personal data for specific purposes (Article 6 para. 1 (a), 7 GDPR, e.g. for the production and publication of photos), we may process the data because your consent constitutes permission. You can revoke such consent at any time. Please note that the revocation affects only future activities. Any processing prior to the revocation is not affected.



#### § 4 RELEVANT DATA

We process all data which you register and provide in the course of your registration for the regatta. These are data from

the following categories: Master data (such as name, address, year of birth), boat number including national identification, club membership or other information voluntarily given by you.

We only process photos / videos of you in the event that you (or your parents on your behalf) have separately and specifically given us permission.

#### § 5 COMMUNICATION OF YOUR DATA

- Responsible Persons To the extent that we are permitted, due to your participation in the regatta and by way of your

consent or due to legal regulations, we communicate your data to third parties for the performance of the regatta. These third parties then process your data under their own responsibility. The following persons and addressees, for example, can thus receive your data:

- adjudication officials or judges commissioned by us for the performance of the regatta.
  - Class associations, German Sailing Association, national sailing associations (e.g. for the purposes of ranking).
  - Public bodies and institutions (such as regulatory authorities) where a legal or regulatory obligation exists.
- Other data recipients may be those for whom you have given us your consent to communicate the data.

- Processors

When implementing and documenting the regatta, we engage external service providers who process personal data on our behalf ("processor"). Specifically, this includes companies in the following categories:

- Technical service providers in the areas of IT and telecommunications (for example, hosting providers), print service providers.
- media and marketing service providers (e.g., web agencies, web designers).
- Photographers / camera staff.

#### § 6 DURATION OF DATA STORAGE

Your personal data is stored by us as far as and as long as this may be necessary in the context of the performance and

documentation of the regatta or other processing purposes for which you have given your consent (e.g. photo use). In any event, the data is stored until the expiry of any appeal periods for protests in the context of the regatta or as long as your consent for the use of your personal data in the form of photos / videos of you remains valid. Result lists are stored until at least the end of the calendar year in which the respective regatta took place. Should statutory or contractual retention periods, requiring further storage of your data as part of regatta participation, prevail beyond this point in time, we will also retain your data for these purposes beyond the end of the calendar year. Data for which there is no statutory or contractual retention obligation beyond the calendar year of the regatta date will be anonymized, unless you have expressly and concretely agreed to the further use of your data. Data for which no anonymization is possible is then destroyed or deleted.





## § 7 YOUR RIGHTS

### A) Right to Information, correction, restriction, deletion and communication

Upon request, we'll be happy to tell you which personal information is being processed by us. Should the data stored by us be erroneous, you are entitled to appropriate correction. You also have the right to block and delete the data stored by us, should the purpose for the processing of the data cease to exist or should other legal requirements prevail. In the event that the deletion contradicts legal or contractual retention or other statutory reasons, access to your data can be blocked but the data cannot be deleted. In addition, you have a right to have your data sent to you.

### B) Right of objection

You have the right, for reasons arising from your particular situation, to object at any time to the processing of your personal data taking place on the basis of a balance of interests (Article 6 para. 1 (f) GDPR). Should you file an objection, we will not process your personal information unless we can demonstrate compelling legitimate grounds for processing which outweigh your interests, rights and liberty, or for the purposes of asserting, pursuing or defending legal claims. The objection can be made free form.
